

•Traditional Framing of the Board Role: Board service operates in service to an organization that seeks to advance the public good. The board is primarily responsible for sustaining and supporting the organization and its ability to exist in service to its mission.

•Purpose-Driven Board Leadership: Board service operates in service to the organization's purpose. The board is primarily responsible for stewarding organizational capacities and maximizing positive impact in service to that core purpose or cause.





#### Q&A: Unified Bars and Federal Litigation

#### What is a unified bar?

The terms *unified* and *integrated* when applied to a bar organization are cocontially synanymous. Unified bars perform regulatory functions as well as a range of other public services and programs designed to enhance the competence and professionalism of bar members, and help the public to understand and access its justice system. Membership is required for lawyers practicing in a unified bar's jurisdiction.

The unified bar concept first came to fruition in North Dakota in 1921. It derived from a recognition that the public obligation of the legal profession goes well beyond adherence to ethical/disciplinary rules. Lawyers, in effect, are the keepers of the justice system. While a healthy system of laws and courts is the foundation of any functional democracy, it fails its primary test if the citizens do not understand and trust, or cannot fully access, its protections. Now 100 years since its establishment, the unified bar model exists in more than 30 U.S. jurisdictions, although how those bars operate varies considerably.



On January 1, 2018, one of the most significant structural reforms in the State Bar of California's history came to fruition: a restructuring that enabled the State Bar to focus solely on its regulatory role and its mission to protect the public.

This was accomplished by separating the State Bar's professional association functions—namely educating attorneys in substantive areas of law, advocating for changes in the law to further the legal profession, and otherwise providing member services and advancing the interests of lawyers—to a new organization, the California Lawyers Association.

This transformational change is still reverberating five years later.
